



The New Brunswick Youth in Care Scholarship

This scholarship covers the cost of tuition and mandatory school fees for students who are or were in the care of the Minister. Care of the Minister means you were in foster care or kinship care (which is care provided by a family member or loved one who is not your parent).

It is also available to youth formerly in the care of First Nations Child and Family Services Agencies.

You are eligible if

- You have spent a total of 365 days in one of the following:
 - Foster care
 - Kinship care
 - Adopted while in the care of the Minister
 - As a client of Youth and Young Adult Engagement Services
 - First Nations Child and family services agencies
- Age 25 or younger when you start school
- Are enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution within New Brunswick taking a program or courses leading to a certification, diploma, or degree

Deadline for applications

September 1st, 2025

- * If you are also receiving student aid funding, the amount of your scholarship will be considered and may result in changes to the amount of student aid you will receive or the creation of overawards.
